# Next Period Tasks

Backfill drain line at the 5<sup>th</sup> with a new perforated pipe and gravel.

Verti draining of fairways and walkways.

Trial new sand in the bunkers at the 10<sup>th</sup>.

Course maintenance 7<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> April, The works carried out on the greens will be- Scarifying at 5mm, Verti drain twice at 200-180mm depths with 17 and 12mm tines, another tining with the procore at 120mm depth with 12mm tines to break up compaction and at different depths to avoid 'panning' then top dressing with 80 tons of sand to fill the holes and help dilute the thatch layer to promote a good healthy deep rooting sward of grass for smooth putting surfaces.

Starting of spring/summer fertiliser program on the Greens and Tees

Setting up the course for the season, New flag poles & hole cups, Tee markers and broken Tee holders out to smarten up the presentation of the course.

Starting of course presentation for the season, Diamond cutting Tees and fairways and block cutting rough

Put out the new bird boxes to encourage more birds, especially starlings that are great for grub control in the turf
